

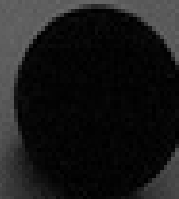

What's a PRS, ARS or SRS Technology?



iClickers... Easy to LEARN...



- Plug and play
- Type questions in any application (PowerPoint, Word, videos, etc).
- Insert spontaneous questions during lecture

and simple to USE... Let's Start!

- 1. Power on clicker by pressing on/off button on the bottom**
- 2. Wait for the polling to start and press the letter that shows your response**
- 3. A green light will flash when your vote has been confirmed**
- 4. You can change your responses anytime a polling remains open -- The receiver will only count the last vote**



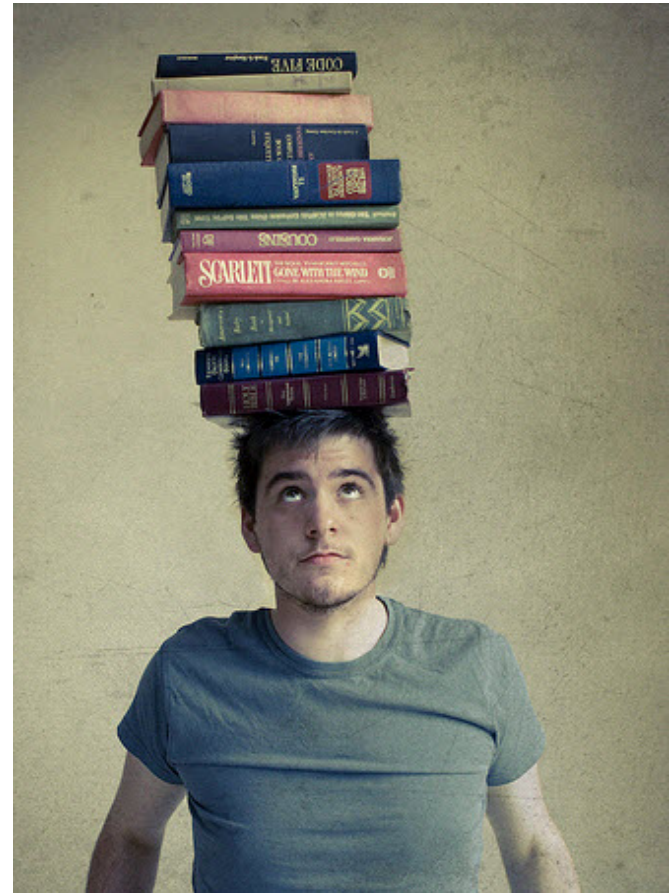

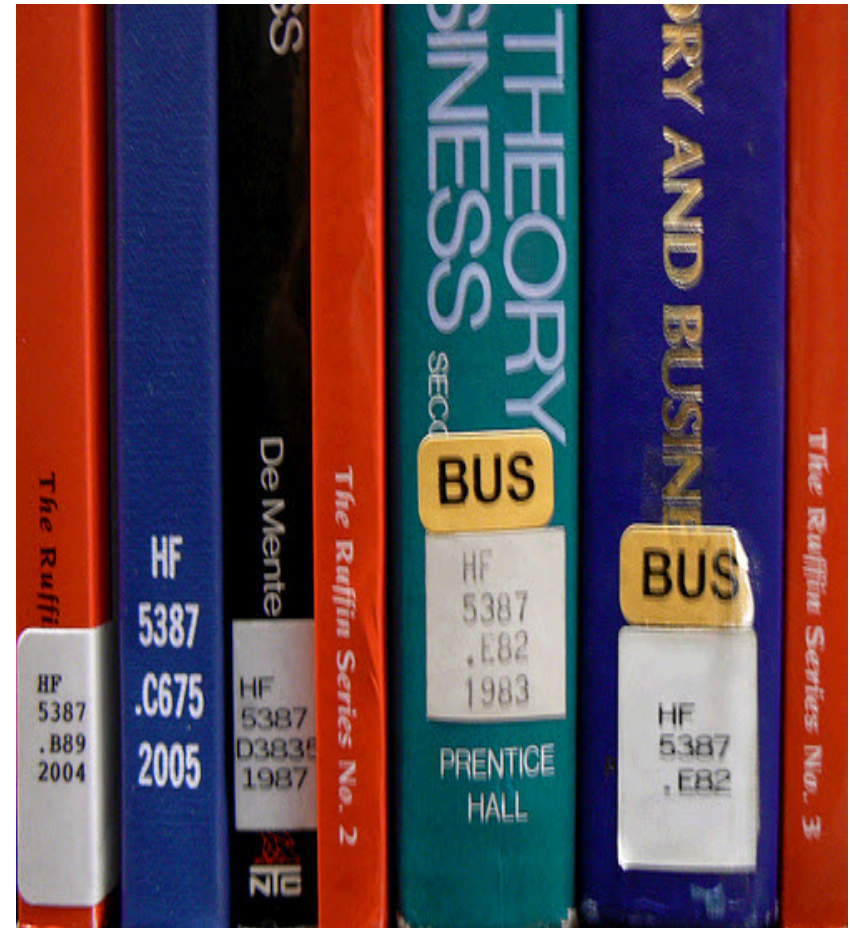

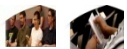
